An urban oasis, Guadalupe Gardens contains the Heritage Rose Garden, a unique collection of 3,600 antique and modern roses; the 3+ acre Historic Orchard, and other demonstration areas -- all irrigated with recycled water and, thanks to volunteer labor, maintained without pesticides.

Guadalupe River Park is a three-mile ribbon of park land that runs along the banks of the Guadalupe River in the heart of downtown San Jose.

Year-round, outdoor activities provide fresh air and exercise as well as team camaraderie! Activities can be from 2-8 hours and vary depending on the season and current needs, can accommodate large groups, and could include tasks such as:
